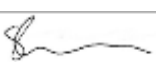

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General Statement of Environmental Policy

I, the Director of Power Testing Limited believe that continuous improvement in environmental management is an essential element within the overall business plan of Power Testing Ltd – minimising waste, consumption of resources and pollution goes hand in hand with high productivity and quality standards.

We recognise and accept our legal Duty of Care towards the environment and wholly support and will comply with or exceed the requirements of current environmental legislation and codes of practice.

- Establishing and monitoring suitable objectives and targets that will promote continual improvement in our environmental performance.
- As far as possible, purchasing products and services that do the least damage to the environment and encouraging others to do the same.
- Assessing the environmental impact of any new processes or products we intend to introduce in advance and seek to reduce these impacts to the lowest practicable level.
- Ensuring that environmental risk controls are considered during the risk assessment process.
- Publicising and promoting this policy among staff, customers and suppliers and, more widely, via our website

To this end, it is our objective to comply with the requirements of ISO14001 and achieve and maintain certification by implementing, following, maintaining and continually improving a comprehensive Integrated Management System

The basis of our environmental management system will be an on-going review of business activities and the identification of aspects of our work that could have an impact upon the environment followed by the implementation of proactive steps to eliminate, minimise or manage them so that adverse environmental effects are minimised.
